

GRADUATE MEDICAL EDUCATION HOTLINE

A hotline has been established for all residents/fellows to use to report duty hour violations; any kind of harassment, bias or discrimination; code of conduct violations; supervision concerns; patient safety concerns; and any other concerns a resident/fellow may have about his/her training program.

Faculty and staff who work with residents/fellows may also use the GME Hotline to report any concerns as outlined above.

To help the GME Office appropriately and thoroughly investigate the concern, it is helpful for the individual reporting the concern to provide as much information as he/she is comfortable providing. This includes but is not limited to specific information about the concern or incident, training program, site, date, and name of any involved persons. The individual reporting the concern may identify him/herself if comfortable doing so.

A concern can be reported to the hotline phone number: **860-679-4353**, or by completing the form on the GME Hotline page <http://gme.uchc.edu/gmehotline>. The hotline is confidential, and all follow-up is done with the reporting individual's identity protected, if requested.
